



Points Allocation – Guidelines and Methodology

The Vice President is responsible for awarding/collating Competition and Clubman Points. Members have the right to challenge these points directly with the Vice President and should petition the VP directly if said Member feels that points should be awarded to themselves, or others – for contribution to the Club or competitive performance. The Vice President shall have “the last word” with regard to points allocation.

Competition Points

1. Drivers' Championship Points

NB - Only entries in Triumph cars are eligible to earn Drivers' Championship points. Refer TSOA WA Competition rules.

Points for Non-Track events are allocated as follows:

- 1st place outright – 10 points
- 2nd place outright – 7 points
- 3rd place outright – 5 points
- 4th place outright – 3 points
- 5th place outright – 2 points
- Unplaced – 1 point

Points for Track events are allocated in cylinder classes (4, 6, & 8 cylinder)

- 1st place outright in class – 10 points
- 2nd place outright in class – 7 points
- 3rd place outright in class – 5 points
- 4th place outright in class – 3 points
- 5th place outright in class – 2 points
- Unplaced in class – 1 point

2. Open Category Points.

Eligible for all TSOA WA members.

- 1st place outright – 10 points
- 2nd place outright – 7 points
- 3rd place outright – 5 points

General

3 points are awarded for organising a Competition Event to the exclusion of entering.

2 points are awarded for assisting in the organisation of a Competition Event to the exclusion of entering.

1 point will be awarded for assisting in the running of a Competition Event.
